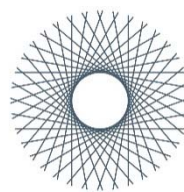

1 APPLYING FOR A SCHOOL PLACE FOR SEPTEMBER 2018

The Herts for Learning Multi Academy Trust is the admissions authority for the Trust's academies.

All academies in the Herts for Learning Multi Academy Trust participate in the co-ordinated admission arrangements operated by Hertfordshire County Council (HCC) for entry into reception.

Section 324 of the Education Act 1996 requires the governing bodies of all maintained schools to admit a child with a statement of special educational needs that names their school. Schools must also admit children with an EHC (Education, Health and Care) plan that names the school.
